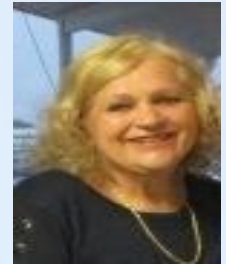

If you have out-of-town friends or family that might be interested in joining NYCP, please give them my information below. I will personally walk them through the membership process.

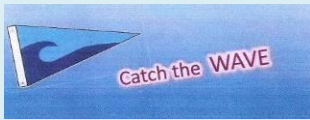
