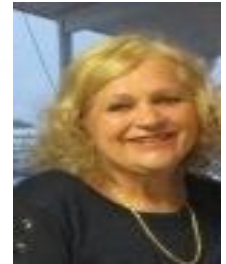

NYCP closed out July with a total Checking Account balance of \$19,816.99 and the Savings account balance is at \$12,001.23.

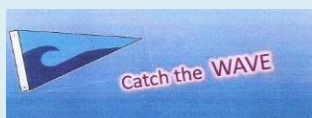
