WAVE was another great success. Many vets and their families came out to enjoy this day on the water and the weather stopped raining long enough to enjoy it.

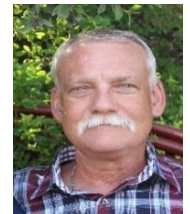
