Happy Summer! The 2023 NYCP new and renewed memberships has grown to 135. Currently, we have 25 out-of-town members. (150 miles or greater)

NYCP out-of-town memberships are open to all active duty, reserve, retired, and veterans of all branches of the US Military, locally assigned Allied Military, full time and retired DOD personnel and dependents.

Out-of-town memberships are \$40 single and \$80 family annually, with a one-time administrative fee of \$30.

Out-of-town members receive an official NYCP membership card. This card may be used at other yacht clubs. Understand, there is no reciprocity at these clubs. Food and drink cost must be paid by the NYCP out-of-town member.
