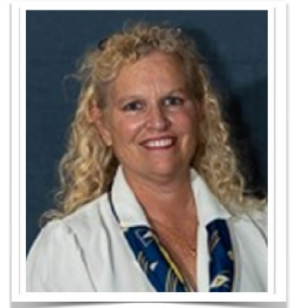

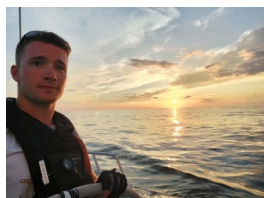
GYA Report

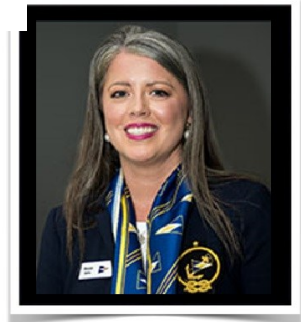

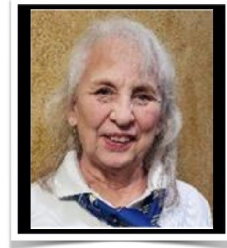
